Greetings Members,

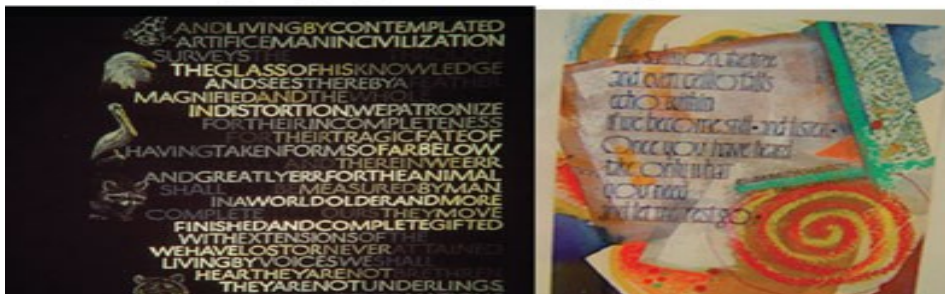
