



The Printmaking, Collage & Assemblage Show

Open to the public, age 18 and older.

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

Any hand-pulled print, collage or 2-D or 3-D assemblage able to be hung will be considered as acceptable.

Artwork must be created from personal photographs or observation. Concept, design and execution should be solely that of the artist. Work from another's copyrighted or published materials is not permitted.

- Submitted works must have been completed within the last **5 years**.
- Limit of **five (5)** entries per Artist.
- Artwork not framed as required or will be disqualified.
- Artwork must not exceed 36" x 36", and weigh under **20 lbs**.
- Original computer art and photographic collage prints are acceptable. No offset printed works.

Irving Art Association reserves the right to reject any works not meeting eligibility requirements, (No Nudes) or deemed inappropriate to hang in the galleries at the Jaycee Park Center for the Arts even after the image is accepted.

PERMISSION AND COPYRIGHT

By submitting an entry, the artist grants permission for IAA to use the accepted image in its newsletter, on its website, for brochures, promotional materials, catalogue, and publicity for this and future shows. The artist certifies that the work submitted is original and does not infringe on any existing copyright. If artwork includes an image of a person, artist certifies that a model release has been obtained.

SUBMISSION ONLINE

Online submission of entry via the IAA website at www.irvingart.org is encouraged but not required. Use the online entry form or email us

at iaaexhibits@gmail.com with title, medium, framed size and price for each item. Optional photographs may be used for publicity purposes.

JPEGS

If submitting images online, only digital images are accepted. **Maximum of 2MB per jpeg.** Images should show only the work of art (no frame, easel or background).

Name each .JPG or .PNG file with the artist's last name and first initial with entry number corresponding to entry number on the form or the title of piece or the title of the work.

CATEGORIES

- 1. Printmaking** – printing on paper or other surface with ink or paint.
- 2. Collage** – with papers, fabric, found objects, wax, etc.
- 3. Assemblage** – 2-D or 3-D artwork made with found objects that meets hanging requirements.

SELECTION of ARTWORK for EXHIBIT

We will attempt to exhibit all pieces entered into the exhibit however some pieces may not be accepted at the discretion of the exhibit committee.

Accepted work must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show.

FRAMING / PRESENTATION

Artwork must be framed and wired with screw eyes or D rings and wire should be approximately 1/3 down and strung tightly across **ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers.** If glazing is used, **any works larger than 16"x20" must be under Plexiglas, with the exception of pastels, which may use glass as long as the 20 lb. total weight limit is observed.** Framing with glazing is recommended for fragile artwork (see Liabilities clause). Wrap-around canvas or cradled panels of at least 1.5" deep may be used, no staples showing with the sides painted or finished.

Keep the framing simple, sturdy and lightweight. Artwork must not exceed **36" x 36"**, **nor be heavier than 20 lbs.**

Failure to comply with the above requirements or the size or weight limits will result in disqualification.

SALES

IAA Exhibit committee member will make the introduction between a potential purchaser and artist but all sales will be arranged between artist and buyer. A commission of **10%** for work sold during the exhibit is payable at the end of the show. The artist is liable for all taxes and commission on these sales. Sold artworks cannot be removed until the end of the show.

LIABILITIES

Although the Irving Art Association, IPAR or the City of Irving will exercise due care in handling works submitted to the exhibition, these entities will NOT be responsible for loss or damage to any artwork.

DELIVERY & RETURNS OF ACCEPTED ENTRIES

Art drop off 10 – 2 pm July 29

Exhibit opens July 30

Reception 2 – 4 pm Aug. 6

Exhibit pickup 10 – 2 pm Aug 26

Any work left after pickup date will be considered property of IAA and disposed of after 15 days.
