JUDGE PANEL

Jim Olvera:

Born in Harlingen, photographer Jim Olvera is a sixth-generation Texan who grew up in Oklahoma City. He attended college at Washington University in St. Louis, where he first studied engineering and architecture, but finding those disciplines too confining, he altered his path in the middle of his junior year to become the university's first photography major. After graduation he moved to Dallas. He has taught at both SMU and TCU, and given numerous lectures and seminars on the subject of photography. His work has been exhibited in many solo and group shows and is included in the Permanent Collection of the Library of Congress.

Douglas D. May:

Douglas D. May has been a design communication professional for close to four decades. Educated at the University of North Texas and Art Center College of Design, he began his career in New York where he trained under several prominent designers and art directors. He received his Master of Fine Arts degree from Texas A&M Commerce in 2017 and now teaches full-time at The University of North Texas. He founded the Dallas-based design firm May & Co. in 1986 and continues to consult with corporations, entrepreneurs, and non-profits by providing design communication to support strategic initiatives. In 2011, Doug was honored as an AIGA Fellow for his professional contribution to the North Texas design community.

CURATOR

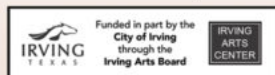
Terry Cockerham:

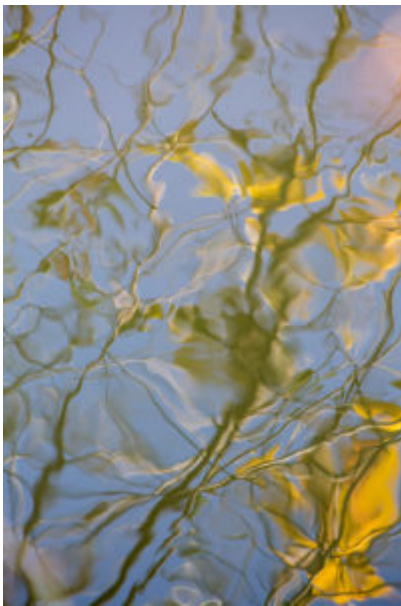
