Supply list:

- acrylic paint & medium
- Bring paper to create prints on — or bring your failed gel prints, etc. Or you can bring a small canvas or art journal (paper useful for gel prints: mixed media, cardstock, deli paper, construction paper, copier paper, scrap paper, old paperbacks, deli paper, drawing paper, cheap watercolor paper)
- Pencils, pens, crayons, pastels etc. for embellishment (optional)
- apron
- paper towels and/or baby wipes
- brushes & tools (mark-making tools, stamps & stencils are useful)
- water container
- palette or paper plates
