

For the 17th year, IAA has hosted a competition featuring animal art. Formerly a national show, this year we returned to a regional scope, putting the emphasis on DFW area artists.

JUDGE PANEL

Brett Dyer:

Brett works as a full-time art professor at North Lake College. Brett also serves as President of the NLC Faculty Association, and Treasurer of the DCCD Faculty Association. Brett offers private workshops at various museums, and art centers. Mr. Dyer has exhibited throughout the USA, garnering numerous awards and scholarships. Brett often donates work to be auctioned off for charity events, and his work can be found as part of many permanent collections in homes, businesses, universities and colleges.

Michael Whiteside:

Michael Whiteside is the Administration and Development Coordinator for DFW Humane Society (and animal lover), and part-time IT Director for Legacy Counseling Center, both nonprofit organizations. Mr. Whiteside is a member of the Association of Fundraising Professionals and on the Board of Directors for Emma's House.

Terry Cockerham:

While Terry was in the military, he took up photography as a hobby. After leaving the military and refining his skills, he then worked for five years at UT Southwestern Medical School as a medical photojournalist during the day while simultaneously teaching photography classes for adults in the evening at one of the local junior colleges. Terry also took on medical illustration for a time as his vocation. Mr. Cockerham now works as a free-lance photographer, and focuses on art photography.

Any animal species was accepted as subject matter for works, both wildlife and domestic, including pets. This year creatures from fantasy, mythology and Cryptozoology were also eligible. Also new for 2018, we have a special challenge category of FROGS & TOADS. 45 artists of all ages entered over 100 pieces of artwork.

The show opened Sunday, August 26th and runs until Sept. 28th at the Jaycee Park Center for the Arts. Gallery hours are Sun., Wed., Thurs. & Fri., from 1 to 4 p.m. and Tues. from 10:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The Awards Reception was held on Sunday afternoon, September 9.
