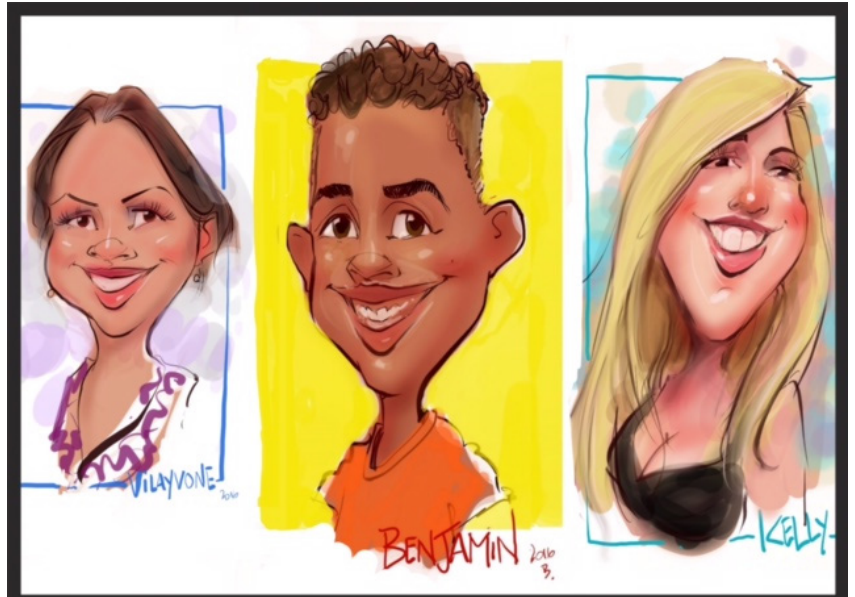

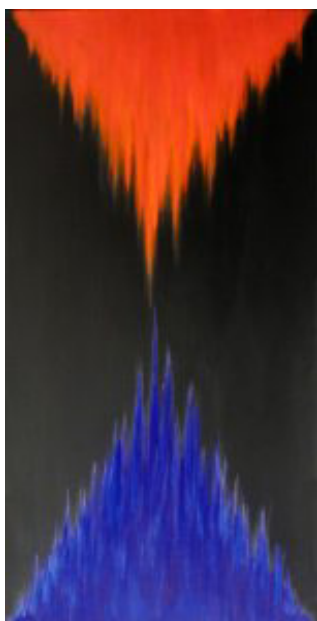

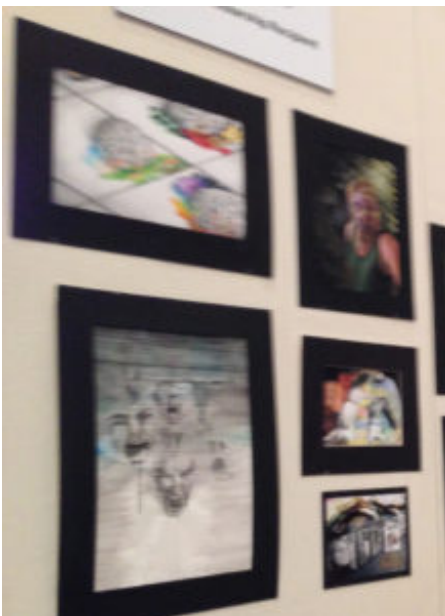
IAA ART SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION NOW OPEN!

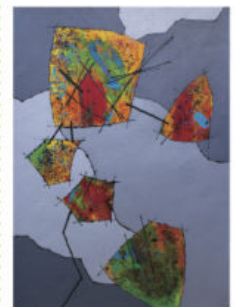
